

## FRESH. MODERN. COLORFUL.



## PINKFRESH STUDIO SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- All Kinds of Wonderful stamp (211923)
- Overlapping Triangles stencils (212323)
- Dies: Shaker Tag Book (173822), Fall Leaf
  (212523), Foliage Shaker (212623), Dotted Chevron
  (211823), Wrap Around Elements (200023),
  Diagonal Stitched Rectangles (PF002ES)
- Glitter Drops: Blush (PF101ES), Champagne (PF094ES)
- PF Tools: 1/2" Blending Brush set (PF105ES), Dual Tip Embellishment Tool (PF108ES), Stamp Press
   Tool (PF092ES), and Triangle Brass Tray (PF087ES)
- PF Ink Colors: Ballet Slipper, Coral Reef, Warm Buff, Detail Black

General supplies: White cardstock, white/ivory/rose gold glitter paper, light brown & pink cardstock, embossing ink, anti static powder tool, iridescent glitter embossing powder, heat tool, diecut machine, paper trimmer, scissors, foam adhesive, liquid glue

## **HOW TO RECREATE:**

1. Cut & fold A2 card base from light brown cardstock.

2. Use the Overlapping Triangles stencils to ink blend a white A2 cardstock panel in the following colors:

Stencil 1: Ballet Slipper Stencil 2: Coral Reef Stencil 3: Warm Buff

3. Before using the last stencil, generously prep your panel with anti static powder.

## Stencil 4: Embossing Ink

- 4. Carefully remove the stencil, then cover in iridescent glitter embossing powder and heat set.
- 5. Diecut the panel with the largest Diagonal Stitched Rectangle, then mount to the card base with foam tape.
- 6. Dry emboss the Dotted Chevron die to white & pale pink cardstock panels, then diecut a tag from each one.
- 7. Diecut the shaker window from the pink tag, then create a shaker element with both pieces & glitter drops.
- 8. Diecut the leaf, foliage, bow and hearts from glitter papers.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment in Detail Black to white cardstock.
- 10. Diecut the sentiment with the coordinating die, along with two additional layers. Stack & glue together.
- 11. Mount the shaker tag to the card front, then layer the diecut pieces & sentiment as shown.
- 11. Accent with glitter drops to finish.
